



What can I do at home?

- Ask your child about the expectations in all areas of the building and how he or she can help others remember and follow them too!
- Discuss the following Gibbs' school wide expectations of "I am Respectful", "I am Responsible", and "I am Safe" with your child. These behaviors will be modeled and taught during the first week of school, retaught as needed, and expected throughout the year.
- Use the PBIS home matrix. Watch for PBIS tips that will be included in the Gibbs' school newsletter. When used consistently and across all settings, positive behavior interventions and supports can dramatically change problem behaviors.
- Research shows that using positive language to praise and/or redirect behavior is very powerful and effective. Try using 4 positive comments to every 1 negative comment.
